We offer this program in partnership with the Télé-université du Québec (TÉLUQ). In it, you will learn to

- * communicate well in both written and oral English
- * understand the structure and the North American social, cultural and linguistic aspects of the English language
- * apply your linguistic skills and cultural knowledge in various areas, including teaching English as a second language (TESL), translation, international business and related fields
- You will take a combination of 30 credits from both Athabasca University and TÉLUQ
- * a minimum of 9 credits of prescribed English language courses
- * a minimum of 9 credits of prescribed culturally focused courses
- * a minimum of 9 credits selected from prescribed courses dealing with various professional applications of the English language
